Compost tea describes a procedure where compost is mixed with water The mixture may be left to stand with minimal disturbance (also called "compost extract" or "steepage") or actively supplied with oxygen by an aquarium pump to stimulate population growth of aerobic microbes This project examined actively aerated compost tea

Brewing Fundamentals - Manual

Pressure brewing is any method that uses pressure to speed up the extraction process While it’s not a manual brew method (because it is controlled by a machine), espresso is the most common type of pressure brewing Another example is the Aeropress, which uses a combination of steeping and low pressure to brew Vacuum/Siphon
